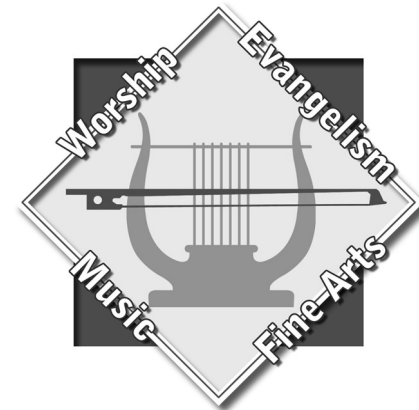

- ❑ Daily practice is vital to success when learning to play an instrument. A minimum of thirty minutes each day is required for best results. Practice cards will be given to instrumental students to keep track of their daily practice. Parents are asked to sign the card and students are to bring the card to class each week.
- ❑ Instrumental students must provide their own instruments and a folding stand. Most instruments can be rented from local music stores. No previous musical instruction or skill is required for Beginning Level classes.
- ❑ Students should arrive for class a few minutes early. Each student will be given a Student Handbook and any curriculum books that they have purchased.

**104 Beginning Strings** **12:20 - 1:05 pm**  
**Age 8 & up - Learn to play the Violin, Viola or Cello**

No previous musical experience necessary. Students will learn proper playing positions, note reading, basic music theory. Students will learn to play holiday music, fun songs and classical music as well as worship music.

**Book fee \$10.00**

**108 Intermediate Strings** **1:10 - 1:55 pm**  
**2nd Year Strings - Violin, Viola or Cello**

This class will continue with the Level 2 Methods book including scale studies, playing positions with continued note reading and music theory. This class will also work on some of the music being used with the string orchestra and will play with them for performances. We will learn to play ensemble music including hymns, classical, contemporary and worship music.

**110 Advanced Instruments** **2:10 - 3:10 pm**  
**String Orchestra - Violin, Viola, Cello or Bass**

The String Orchestra will include all violin, viola, cello and string bass students who have played their instrument for two or more years. Music theory, scales and etudes will be incorporated into all lessons. We will learn to understand chords and how to play by ear. A variety of ensemble music, including quartets and chamber music, with holiday, contemporary, classical and worship music will be studied and performed.
